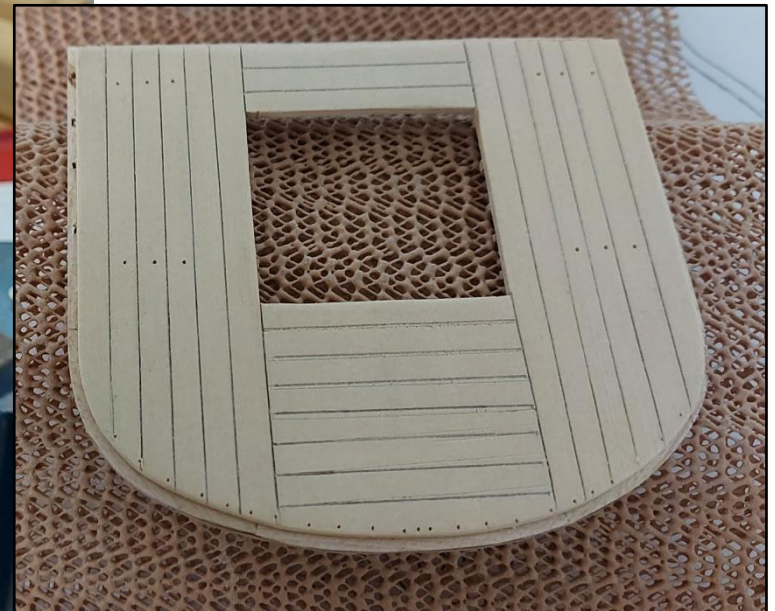




LUBBER'S HOLE

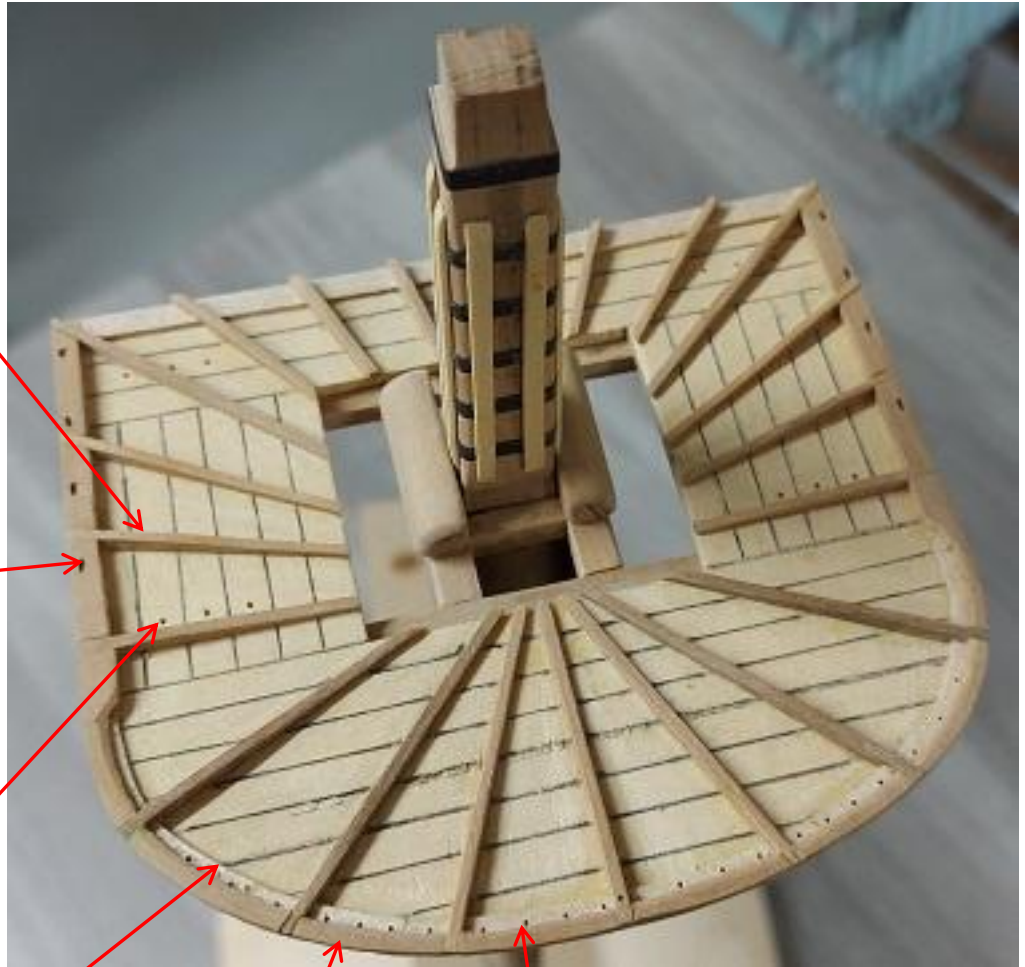
